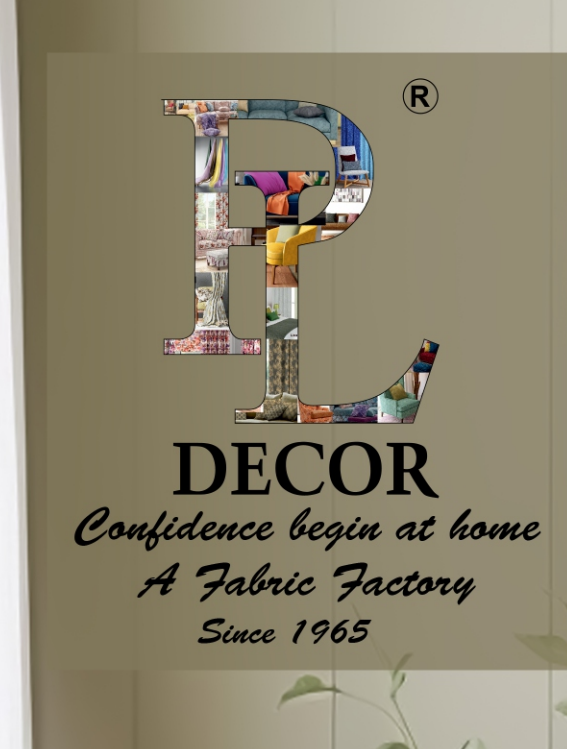




BENIN (AGAINST SUN)

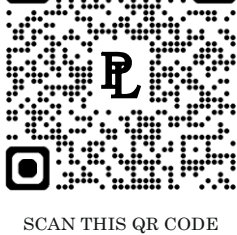
BENIN (AGAINST SUN)
