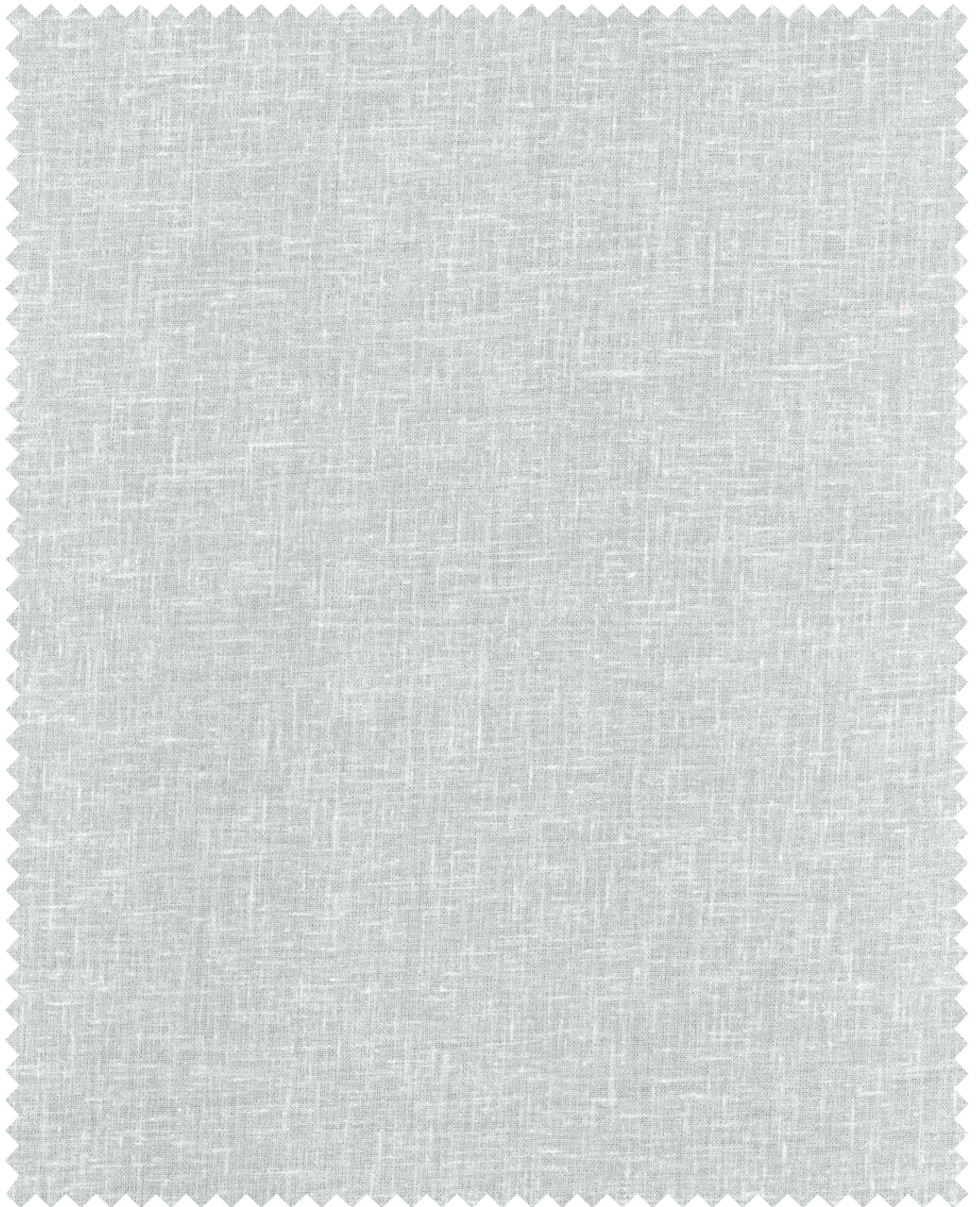


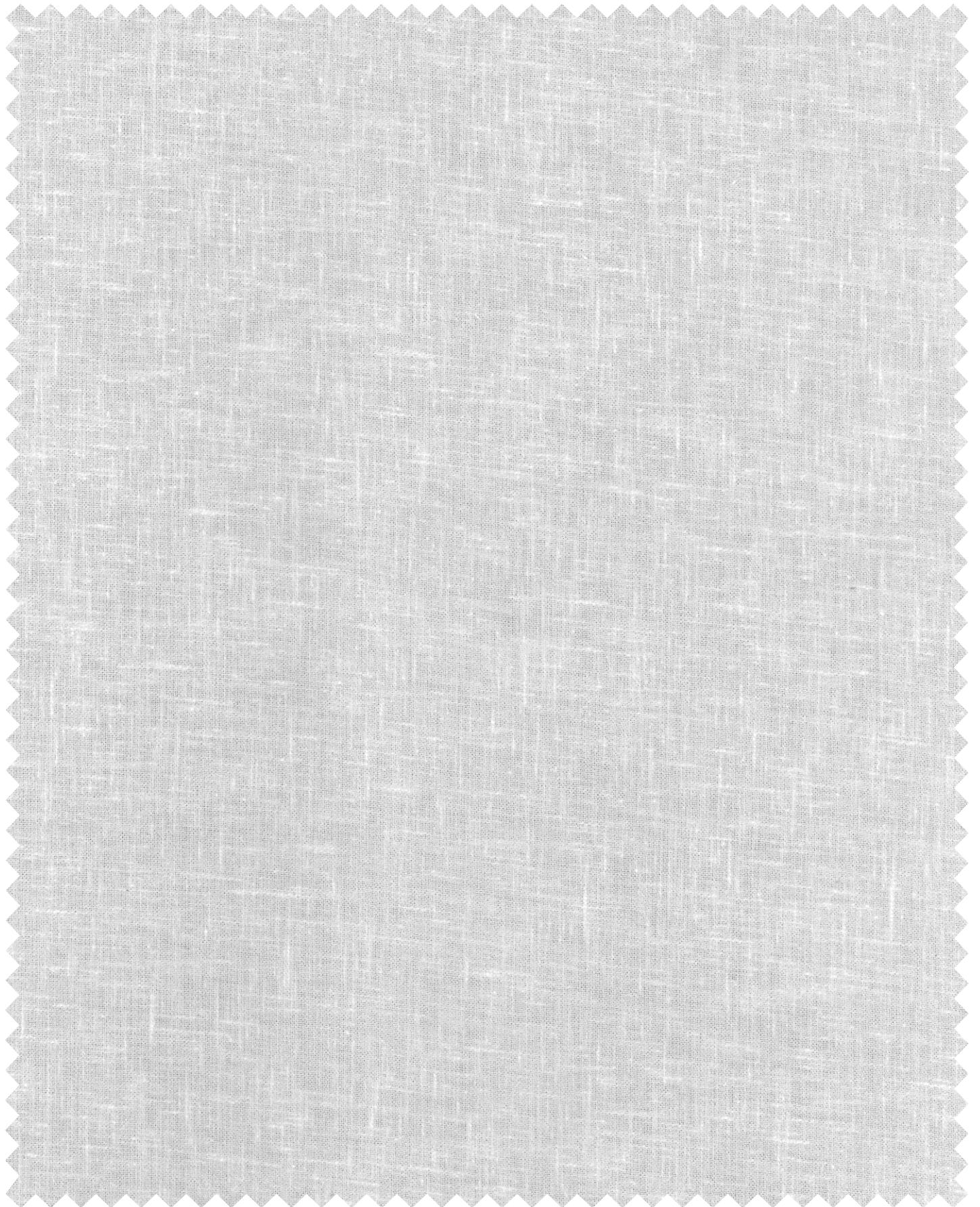




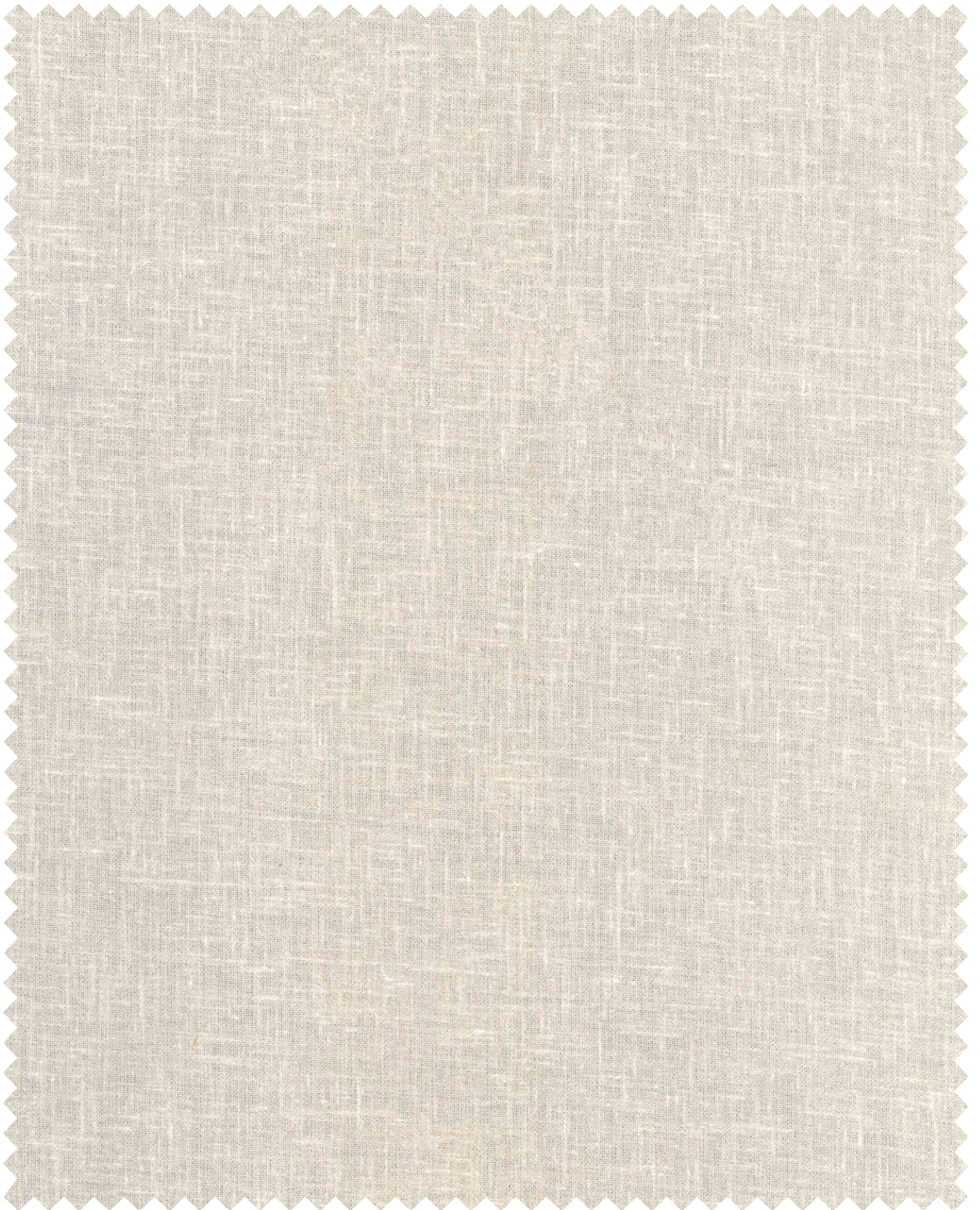






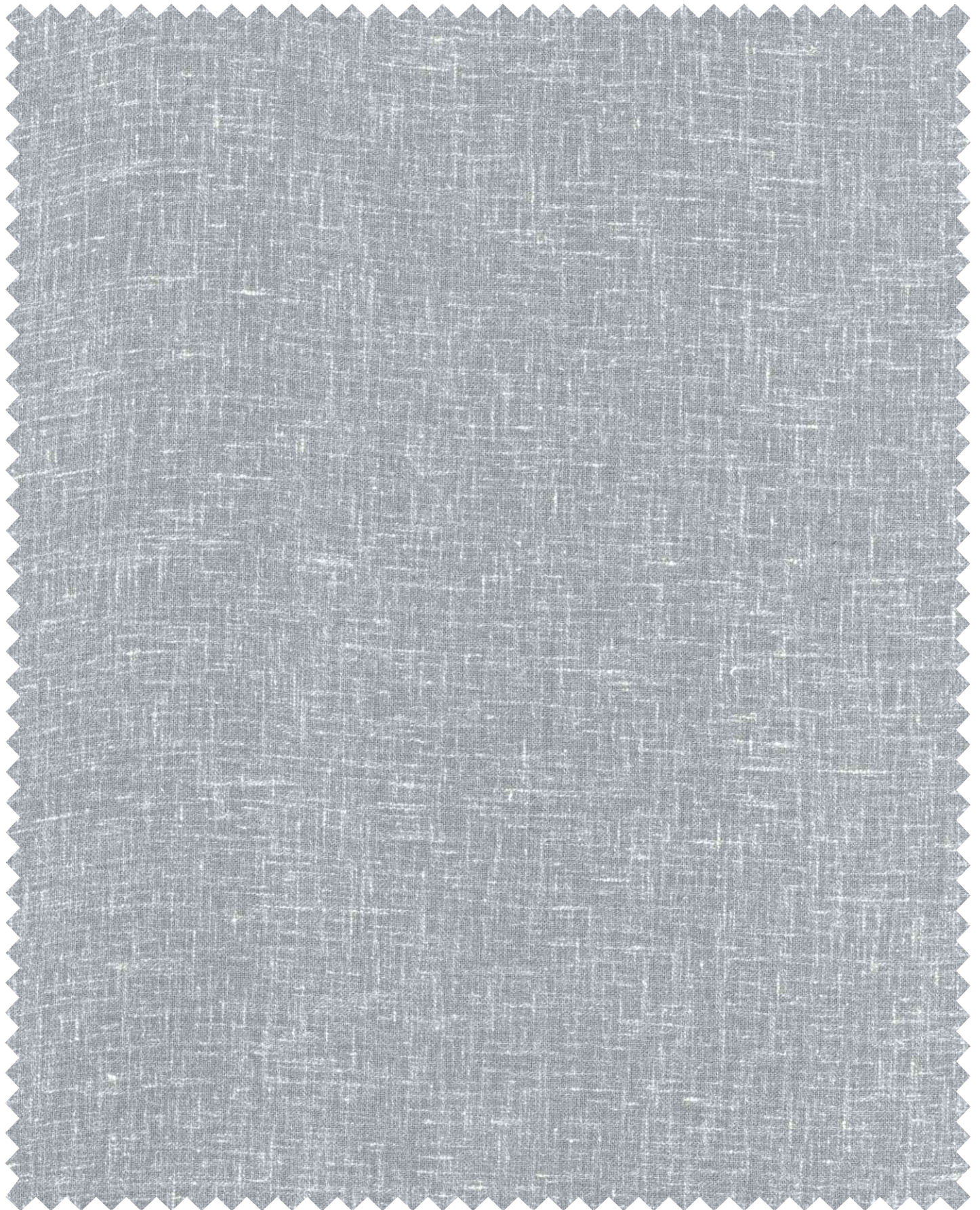


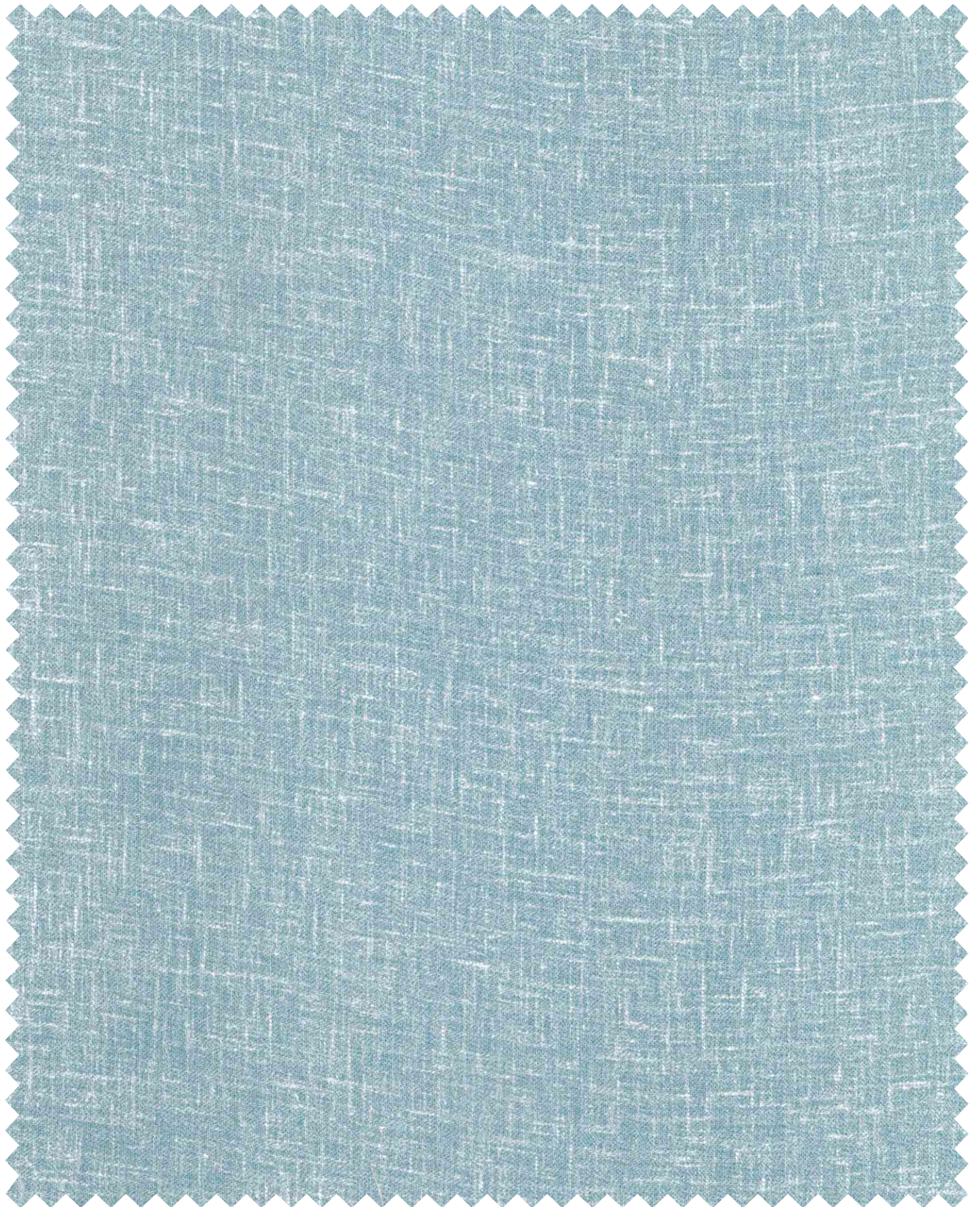


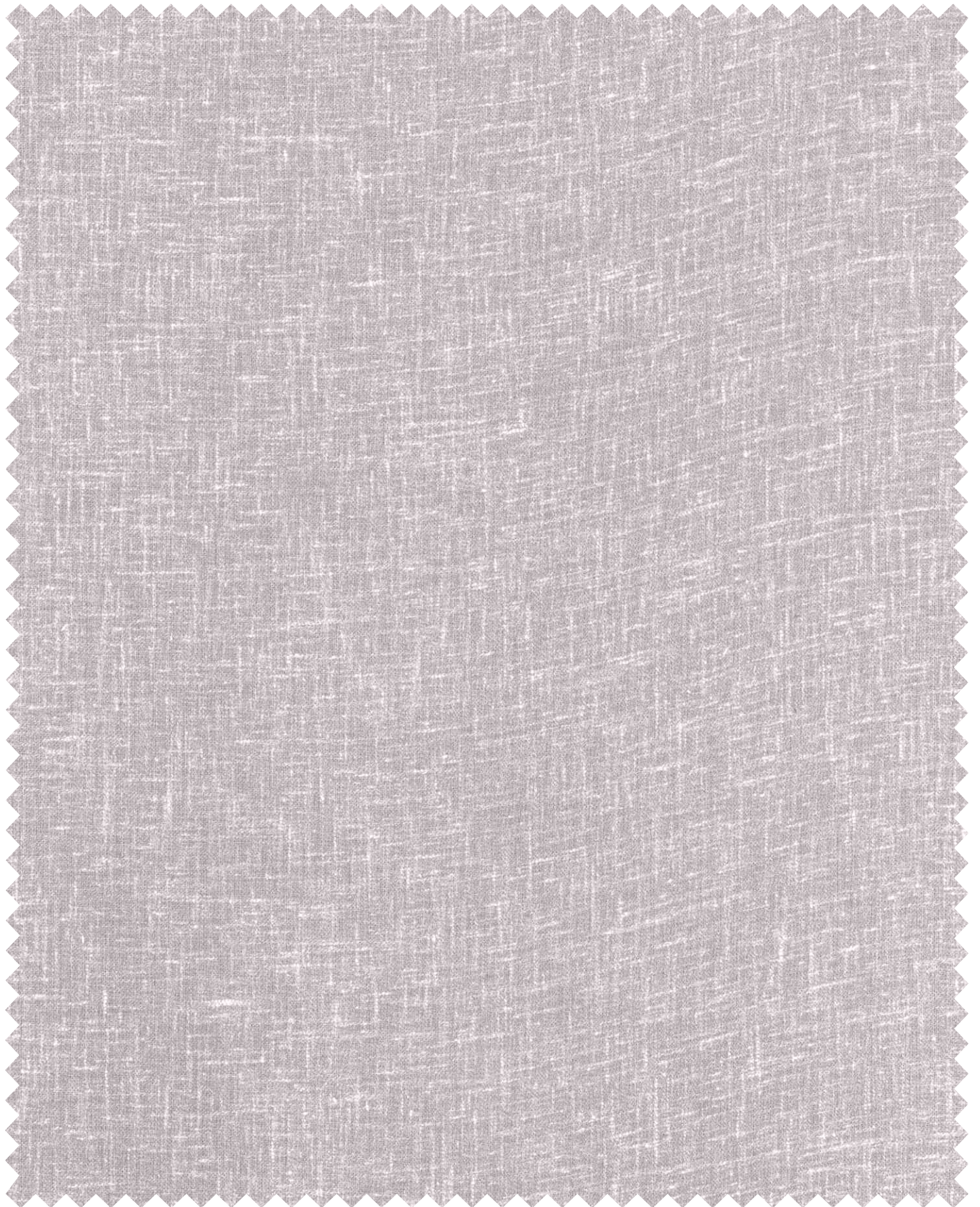












COTTON FABRIC TO SUN (100% BLACKOUT)

- Blackout shades block out all sunlight. These shades provide total privacy both day and night. Blackout shades enhance sleeping. They work best in rooms that require total darkness. For example, people choose to install them in their bedrooms, in media or entertainment rooms, and in nurseries.
- Eliminating or reducing light exposure, which can disrupt your sleep and leave you feeling too tired during the day. Helping maintain your natural circadian rhythm. Increasing the privacy of your home at night. Reducing your home cooling costs by shading your bedroom from summer sunlight.
- Cotton Blackout curtains are made from a lighter triple weave fabric which is designed to block out light, compared to Thermal curtains which are made from 3 layers of thick fabric.
- 100% blackout curtains are designed to provide complete darkness by ensuring that no light can penetrate, making them ideal for those who require total darkness for sleep. In contrast, 95% blackout curtains, while still effective, allow a small amount of natural light to filter through.
- When choosing a material for blackout curtains, heavy microfiber fabric is an excellent option as it can help to increase the insulating properties of the curtains, and polyester fabrics are preferred for making blackout curtains for several reasons.
- Blackout curtains and shades will reduce the amount of heat which is transferred via your windows by as much as 24 percent, keeping the rooms where they're installed cooler in summer and warmer in winter. This will allow you to use your heating and cooling system more efficiently and save energy.

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What is blackout fabric?

Blackout fabric is a specialised material used in the manufacturing of blackout curtains. The key to its effectiveness lies in the 3 coating process:

1. First Pass

The back of the fabric is coated with a foam layer to add thickness and help block out light.

2. Second Pass

A black opaque layer is added on top of the foam. This means no light can pass through the fabric.

3. Third Pass

A white or coloured layer is then applied to give the fabric a finished look. This also helps to provide additional insulation and durability.

How do blackout curtains work?

The main function of blackout curtains is to block light. The fabric used in these curtains is coated with a 3 process, including an opaque layer that prevents light from passing through. Blackout curtains often double up as insulation because their multi-layered construction means they help to maintain a consistent indoor temperature.

The dense fabric of blackout curtains also helps to dampen sound. While not soundproof, they can significantly reduce the amount of noise entering a room as their heavy material absorbs sound waves. So, for people who live in busy urban areas or near noisy streets, they're helpful.

What are blackout curtains made of?

Blackout curtains are made from a combination of materials that offer light-blocking properties and durability. Cotton is another popular fabric. While on its own it's not as effective at blocking light, as a base fabric with coatings, it is suitable for blackout curtains. Cotton has a soft, natural texture and is often chosen for its breathability as well as its aesthetic appeal.
